This anniversary has significance for Duxbury as some of the original Mayflower Pilgrims settled here shortly after they landed in Plymouth.

Each photograph in this book offers a modern-day snapshot of the natural splendor and unique spirit of Duxbury, as seen through the lenses of twenty-six Duxbury Camera Club members. Everywhere we look, we are reminded of Duxbury's past, and its role in helping to shape our present.

Although the images in this book were taken recently, many of them echo the Town's rural, agricultural, and maritime past: the Myles Standish Monument, for instance, erected to commemorate the military leader of the Plymouth Colony; open fields where the town's farming community toiled throughout the 17th century; cranberry bogs where the Wampanoag shared their agricultural experience with the European settlers; and the Old Shipbuilder's Historic District along the shores of Duxbury Bay and Bluefish River.
